The third verse, "For all the travels and troubles that face me I'll lead the fight, cuz I see with the eyes my daddy gave me," perfectly expresses how being grounded in your roots provides the strength you need to walk into your future.

The smooth, rich tone of Pigott's vocals mirror the stability that comes from living a grounded life, while the rhythmic, joyous instrumentation reflects the exciting, unknown nature of what is yet to come.

Drawing inspiration from his own personal life, Pigott crafts a beautiful image of the meaning of fatherhood and generational love. "Having lost my father to cancer when I was eight, music was my way of remaining connected to his musical spirit," Pigott explained, "*Eyes my Daddy Gave Me* partly speaks to my journey as a boy and man growing up without an earthly father."

After the birth of his twin boys, Pigott's understanding of the significance of fatherhood completely changed. He shared, "I understand that I can be a light for my sons and wife in the way I choose to live. It is the responsibility of a good father to lead by example."
